

## To the Citizens of Signal Mountain

Due to the recent recall, there is an opening on the Signal Mountain Town Council. The Council has the responsibility to fill this vacancy within 30 days from this Thursday, November 16, 2006. We are encouraging citizens who might be interested in serving to submit a letter of interest. We would recommend that you include any information about yourself that you feel would help us in making our decision. We ask that all letters of interest be submitted to Diana Campbell, Town Manager at the Town Hall. All letters must be submitted by the end of business on Wednesday, November 22, 2006. You will be provided with a questionnaire composed by the Council which we request that you complete and return by the end of business on Monday, November 27, 2006.



The Town Charter states that "only registered voters of the Town who are bona fide citizens, and residents of the Town, shall be eligible to seek and hold the office of Councilmember or Mayor." It also states "Except where authorized by law, no Councilmember shall hold any other elected Town, county, state or federal office during the term for which he was elected to the Council. No Councilmember shall hold any other Town office or employment during the terms for which he was elected to the Council. No former Councilmember shall hold any compensated appointive office or employment with the Town until one (1) year after the expiration of the term for which elected to the Council."
