The Town Council of the Town of Signal Mountain held a special work session on Monday, March 26, 2001, at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. Those present were:

Hershel Dick informed the Council that there would be a bid opening on Monday, March 30, 2001, 2:00 p.m. for the Driver Field lights. In order to expedite the project, he requested that the Council approve the Town Engineer's estimate of \$15,000. Councilmember Bryant made a motion to give the Town Manager approval to award a bid up to \$15,000. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Steele and passed unanimously.

Tamara Beasley, representing girls softball along with several other members of the girls softball league, spoke before the Council. They explained that the girl's softball season ran from mid-April until the end of May. They were concerned that their season was being interrupted with the work on Marion and Driver Fields.

Dwayne McCamish and Raymond Barnes, former chairmen of the Recreation Advisory Board, informed the Council that many years ago they started a scholarship program for boy's baseball. At this time, they wish to donate approximately \$13,000 that they have accumulated to boy's baseball.

The Council, the Recreation Board and others discussed the Recreation Board's list of capital improvements. The Recreation Board members talked about the various projects and the priority of each. It was decided the Recreation Board would do some additional work on developing priorities and gather additional information for the Council.
