

*****JULY 28, 2005*****

The Town Council held a Special Called Town Council Meeting/ Work Session July 28, 2005, at 6:00 p.m. at Town Hall.

The Council briefly discussed the renewal of a contract with the Humane Society for animal control in the Town.

Next the Council discussed the subject of organized sports in the Town and the use of the Town's fields by the sports groups. It was noted that an important concern of the Councilmembers was injuries to the players and the need for safe practices. They agreed that each sport must have insurance covering the Town. Councilmember Linehart suggested asking the new tackle football group to come to the Council meeting on August 8, 2005.

The Mayor informed the Council that there was a meeting with the citizens that live on Ohio Avenue across from the Rainbow Lake parking lot on August 10, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall.

The Council discussed the request by the citizens on Albert Road for some way to control the speed on that street. The placement of a three way stop sign at Albert and Brockton was discussed. The Town Attorney talked about the need to follow the criteria in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control published by the U. S. Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration.


