The Town Council of the Town of Signal Mountain held a special called meeting on Monday, July 10, 2006, at 5:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. Those present were:

Mayor Leonard called the meeting to order.

Diana Campbell explained that Honna Rogers, who was to be present at the meeting, was ill and could not attend. Ms. Campbell explained to the Council that Ms. Rogers was doing her internship through MTAS and she was putting together the Job Description Manual for the Town.

There was a brief discussion regarding trying to schedule a garbage presentation by Pat Brown; however, no date was definitely decided.

Mayor Leonard then addressed the issue of the Mountain Arts Community Center and the fundraising. He said MACC might possibly be able to hold the fundraisers at a private residence or even the Signal Mountain Golf and Country Club. Councilmember Paturalski said the Town was still leasing the building from Hamilton County and the County had certain restrictions on their property.

Diana Campbell discussed the ad to be published regarding the new Librarian due to the fact Connie Pierce's last day was July 7. Mayor Leonard then asked that the Resolution regarding Ms Pierce be re- read at the evening meeting.

Councilmember Linehart said he would like to meet again with SunTrust Bank and Tennessee Municipal Bond Funding, back-to-back, and revisit the presentations. Diana Campbell asked if Monday July 31 would be a good time and all Councilmembers agreed.

Councilmember Paturalski asked about the Plan of Services for Fox Run and Windtree and where the Town was with that. Mr. Noblett said the Town had a month for annexation but there must be a Plan of Services in place.
