The Town Council of the Town of Signal Mountain held a special called work session meeting on Monday, April 10, 2006, at 5:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. Those present were:

Mayor Leonard called the meeting to order.

Mayor Leonard stated the sidewalk grant was a key concern to the Signal Mountain Golf and Country Club.

Mr. Bill Kennedy was present representing the Signal Mountain Golf and Country Club with concerns of the sidewalk path going down the Club side and questioned what other options there might be. Councilmember Linehart said to ask if it was possible to move the walkway to the other side of road. Oliver Benton said he had walked the area and there was no room between the trees and road to put a sidewalk.

Councilmember Paturalski questioned if it would be possible to move the grant funds to repair the sidewalks in the Ole Towne area. Attorney Noblett said that would be similar to the Wildflower Park issue. Ms. Campbell said she would contact Karen Rhodes regarding this matter.

Councilmember Linehart said the Club is a great neighbor for the community. It allowed the Signal Mountain Middle School girls and boys golf teams as well as the Red Bank golf team to practice approximately two times per week during the golf season and allowed them to play six of their matches at the golf course. They helped in the raising of approximately \$75,000 for the Thrasher Elementary gym and \$36,000 for the Mountain Education Fund. Oliver Benton said the Club had been more supportive the last ten years. Councilmember Paturalski said some citizens would not have moved to Signal Mountain if not for the Signal Mountain Golf and Country Club.


