The Mayor opened the meeting with the Pledge to the Allegiance to the Flag and offered the prayer. The Acting Recorder called the roll.


The Mayor then addressed the group. He complimented the Planning Commission and Council on the work on the zoning ordinance amendment. He said education was a very important part of the solution. He then proposed to the Council to have a well publicized and well announced meeting and invite all the principal people involved in the progress, Attorney Noblett, Mike Howard of the WWTA, Karen Rennich of the Regional Planning Agency and other so that information could be provided to help make a well informed decision. He said they would ask the developers and land owners to bring their vision or philosophical strategy to share if they had considered what they might do with their land. He said with the information the Council could then focus and make a decision.

Councilmember White said he thought that would be a great idea. He said that every citizen could attend so they could be well informed. Vice Mayor Ruffin suggested the meeting be in the evening. Councilmember Paturalski said she liked the idea. She said many people had not read all the options and most were focusing on just one. She said she would like everyone to hear from Phil and the Council could use the education as well. She said she wanted to leave enough time to hear from everyone that wanted to speak. The Mayor said that non residents in the area deserved a voice. He said they will be most affected. He said Walden was invited also.

The Mayor then made a motion to conduct a public meeting in a couple of weeks to be published and advertised. Vice Mayor Ruffin seconded the motion. The Council voted unanimously for the meeting.

They discussed having information such as maps and the amendment document available at the Townhall. They said the amendment would be on the Town's website.

The Council set the date for the meeting as May 24th at 7:00 p.m. in the Town gym.
