Sam Powell gave two maps to the Council one of the Shackleford Ridge Park/Rainbow Lake Trails and one of the Green Gorge Trail and explained how he would like for the two trails could come together.

The Council discussed projects for the year 2008/2011 Transportation Improvement Program. Councilmember Lusk said this information must be submitted by March 14, 2007 to be eligible for funding.

The Council agreed the transportation projects by priority were:

1. Intersection at traffic signal
2. Intersection at Mississippi Avenue and Maryland Avenue
3. Intersection at James Blvd., Texas Ave. and Timberlinks
4. Shackleford Ridge Sidewalk Project
5. Commercial Area Feasibility Study
6. Library-James Blvd, to Texas Ave. Sidewalk Project
7. Green Gorge to Rainbow Lake Sidewalk Project/Old Towne Sidewalk Rehabilitation
8. Timesville Road Study
9. Reversible Lane Up and Down the Mountain
10. Drainage Issues-Variou Roads
11. Doubling Size of Sign Board and Improving the Landscaping
