

*****APRIL 27, 2007*****

The Town Council of the Town of Signal Mountain held a special called meeting on Friday, April 27, 2007, at 10:00 in the Town Hall. Those present were:

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

The Council discussed the changes that might be made at the traffic light intersection and CVS. The items that would be done include 1)changing the traffic light to have a dedicated turn for Palisades and Mississippi, 2) signage to show no left turn into CVS when traveling down the mountain, 3) signage to show no left turn out of the CVS parking lot onto Ridgeway Avenue, 4) signage and surface painting to show left turn only from Signal Mountain Boulevard when in the left lane, and 5) signage and surface painting to show right turn only from Signal Mountain Boulevard when in the right lane. It was decided to have Loretta Hopper make a presentation at the May 14, 2007 meeting.

The Council request that the book of board members be updated with the newly appointed board members. It was decided to fix the dates where possible to expire December 31.

The Council discussed the upcoming presentation by Randal Arendt. Karen Rennich stopped by the Town hall and discussed with the Council the dates and times. She explained that she did not have a definite time for the May 15th meeting downtown. She did inform the Council that she had secured the Chattanooga Theatre Center for the event. She said the presentation would be in their auditorium and then those staying for the workshop would move to another room for the workshop. The said the Council and Planning Commission would meet with Mr. Arendt on the 16th at 11:30 to 1:00 with lunch provided by the Town. She said the meeting for the evening of the 16th would be at the MACC at 7:00 p.m. After the discussion Karen left the meeting.

Ms. Campbell asked about the proposed deletions from the current Land Use Plan. It was decided to leave in the information about populations and history and leave in the information on subdivisions.


Page 2 – Minutes of the Special Called Meeting on April 27, 2007
