The Council discussed with Public Works Director, Loretta Hopper recycling issues and working with Orange Grove. The also discussed the new employee position of Engineering Technician.


The Council discussed other resolutions and ordinances that would be needed for the September 10, 2007 regular meeting or future meetings.
