Town Recorder Mark Johnson


The Council reconvened its previous meeting on April 30, 2010 to continue discussing the FY 2010-2011 budget.

Various issues were discussed, including the high school debt, employee compensation, and the proposed vehicle replacement plan.

Ms. Rogers informed the Council that an individual had requested a zoning variance to allow the establishment of a therapeutic massage practice. The Council agreed to have the Planning Commission review the request.

Ms. Rogers reminded the Council that Windy Way is in disrepair and therefore an emergency spending request may be presented in the near future.
