

Council Notes-November 18, 2009

- At the Council's regular meeting, November 9th, Mayor Bill Lusk presented the annual State of the Town Report for fiscal year 2008-09. The report details the accomplishments of the Council and Town employees as well as the challenges and opportunities that lie ahead. The report is posted on the Town website.
- After considerable study, the Council confirmed its decision not to employ the use of photo speed enforcement. It also decided, based on new information from the state, not to consider setting a referendum for citizens to decide whether to raise the sales tax. In other business, the Council passed an ordinance required by the state authorizing the Town to contract with a collection agency to collect delinquent municipal court fines and costs.
- The Council presented an Honorary Resolution to the SMHS Ladies Golf Team, coached by Wes Moore, recognizing Jordan Britt and the Team for winning the school's first individual and team state championships.
- The Town is still accepting applications from residents, wishing to serve on Town Boards. The boards and the number of positions to be filled are as follows: Zoning Appeals (1); Design Review (3); Mountain Arts Community Center (1); Parks (1); Personnel (3); Planning (3); and, Historical. Call the Town Manager for more information. Board application forms may be downloaded from the Town website and dropped off or mailed to the Town Hall.
- Regular curbside leaf pickup began November 9th. A map is posted on the Town website that designates the pickup areas, where the crews are currently working, and where they will be working next.
- There will be no Thursday garbage pickup on Thanksgiving Day, November 26th. Pickup will occur on Wednesday, November 25th instead. Both the Transfer Station and the Recycle Center will be closed on November 26th and Friday, November 27th.
