- The Planning Commission's next regular meeting is tomorrow, December 3rd at 6pm at the Town Hall. The Commission will continue its review of a request by Blue Highway Development Partners to re-zone the property on the hillside behind the old CVS between Lancaster and Cauthen Way from Low-Density Residential to Highway Commercial. The Partners want to build a 45,000 sq. ft. neighborhood grocery store and another 6,600 sq. ft. building for shops. The Regional Planning Commission has recommended to the Town that the property be re-zoned with certain conditions.
- The Town Manager recently recognized Police Officer Jane Phipps, the Town's Victim Assistance specialist, for her conscientious service by naming her the Town's "Employee of the Quarter".
- At its November 9th meeting, the Council appointed Bonnie Hamilton to serve on the Historical Committee.
