- The Town Hall will be closed from 11:30am to 1:00pm on Friday, December 18th for the Employee Christmas Luncheon.
- Town Manager Honna Rogers attended the Tennessee Municipal League District Meeting on December 3rd for an update and review of the 2009 legislative session and a preview of the upcoming 2010 legislative session. Insufficient funding was and is the primary challenge for the legislature for both 2009 and 2010.
- The Planning Commission's next regular meeting will be held on January 7, 2010 at 6:00 at the Town Hall. The Commission will elect officers for the year and will again consider a request by Gary Greve of Blue Highways Development Partners and Frank Powell of Lookout Mountain Investment Company to rezone the property behind Signal Crossing from Low Density Residential to Highway Commercial District.
- The repair work to the roof and ceilings at the MACC is estimated to cost as much as \$300,000. With the exception of the cafeteria and the two temporary classrooms in the back, the MACC will have to remain closed until the repairs are completed. Citizens are encouraged to add the MACC to their Christmas lists. Donations, which will be most appreciated, may be mailed or dropped off at the Town Hall at 1111 Ridgeway Avenue.
- Please remember our Town employees at Christmas. The Employee Christmas Fund will be divided among Town Employees. The Police and Fireman's fund will be divided among the police and firemen. Donations boxes for each fund are located at the Town Hall.
- Please place carts 2 to 3 feet away from other objects and out of leaf piles. Also, remember to bag items before putting them in garbage carts. If the garbage cart lids are not completely closed, carts will not be emptied.
