- The Town Hall, the Recycle Center and the Transfer Station will be closed Friday, January 1st, New Year's Day.
- The Council's first agenda meeting of the New Year will occur on Monday, January 4th at 10am. Included on the agenda is a proposal from Kennedy, Coulter, Rushing and Watson, LLC, to guide the town through a public process to complete a commercial development plan and create new design standards. The original \$50,000 proposal has been revised and re-submitted at a cost of \$25,000. The Council also plans to vote on a recently negotiated Comcast Cable Franchise Agreement and to discuss board appointments. The Council's next regular meeting will be held at 6:30pm on Monday, January 11th.
- On Thursday, January 7th, the Planning Commission will meet at 6:00pm at the Town Hall. The Commission will elect officers and will again consider a request by Gary Greve of Blue Highways Development Partners and Frank Powell of Lookout Mountain Investment Company to rezone the property behind Signal Crossing from Low Density Residential to Highway Commercial.
- The Council has appointed David Cantrell to the Board of Zoning Appeals; Elaine Preston, John Wynne, David Reed, and Mary Scott Norris to the Historical Committee; Jerry Robertson, Alan Derthick, Jim Raulston, Hunter Swink, and Noah Long to the Adjustment and Appeals for Mechanical Codes Board; Sam Powell to the Parks Board; Tom Heys, Robbie Henderson and Teresa Jones to the Personnel Committee; Melissa Cantrell and Guy Beatty to the Planning Commission; and, Anne Hagood to the Tree Board.
