- Thompson Engineering is hosting a drop-in style public meeting on the James Boulevard sidewalk extension between Maryland and the Library on February 3rd between 6-8pm at the Town Hall. Everyone is invited to stop by to ask questions and make comments. Comments may also be made on the Town Website through February 3rd. Click on “Submit Comments” under “Public Meeting.” Name and address are required.
- Kennedy, Coulter, Rushing and Watson have begun background work on the public process to obtain the community’s vision on future commercial development. Results will be used as a basis for the review and revision of the Town’s existing commercial design standards. More information will be forthcoming. Plan on getting involved.
- At a special meeting on January 19th, the Design Review Commission welcomed new members and discussed its role in the review and revision of the Town’s design principles and standards. The DRC is the Town board responsible for regulating commercial signage, lighting, landscaping and design guidelines. The DRC also changed its regular meeting day from the fourth Monday in the month to the fourth Tuesday at 6:00pm.
- At its January 21st meeting, the Planning Commission unanimously elected Melissa Cantrell chairman, Cheryl Graham vice chairman, and Wayne Williams secretary. Since Blue Highways Development had postponed its third request to re-zone the property behind the old CVS until the Commission’s next regular meeting on February 4th, the Commission resumed its review of Article VI of the Subdivision Regulations.
- The Council’s next agenda meeting will be held on Friday, January 29th at 10am. EPB will be present to discuss the Town’s franchise agreement.
- Arbor Day is Friday, March 5th. This year’s theme is “Trees are terrific...and energy wise.” Fifth graders from the elementary schools will celebrate with the Tree Board by planting trees.
