

## Council Notes-February 17, 2010

- At its regular meeting on February 8<sup>th</sup>, the council tabled the final reading of an ordinance re-zoning the SMMS property as per a request by Tom Poteet because the title company has not yet issued the warranty deed. Mr. Poteet hopes to re-develop the SMMS site into a health and wellness campus.
- The town manager informed the council that contractors, who have recently inspected the roof replacement and ceiling reconstruction plans for the Mountain Arts Community Center, have recommended the town hire an architect to address the structural aspects of the project. The council agreed.
- The council appointed Judy Beaty and Dick Morel to serve on the Library Board. A resolution was read commending the Thrasher Environment Club, which began in 1999. A resolution was also read commending “Kids in the Kitchen”, a health and fitness event sponsored by the Junior League of Chattanooga, to be held at Thrasher Elementary School on March 13<sup>th</sup> between 10am-2pm. The event is free and the public is invited.
- Orange Grove has suggested that the town participate in a pilot program to determine the need for a public document shredding service for sensitive materials and records. Orange Grove already provides such service to businesses and the federal government.
- Effective 1/1/10 the State of Tennessee now administers business license and tax return processing. Existing businesses will file returns and payments directly with the State Department of Revenue.
