- At its March 4<sup>th</sup> regular meeting, the Planning Commission neared the completion of its revision of the subdivision regulations. The next step will be to send the completed draft to the Regional Planning Agency for review.
- On Friday, March 5<sup>th</sup>, Tom Poteet's purchase of the SMMS property was finalized—at last!
- The March council meeting will be held Monday, March 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm at the town hall.
- Thursday, March 25<sup>th</sup> is the date for the public input meeting with planners Kennedy, Coulter, Rushing and Watson. The meeting is designed for attendees to define and comment on the qualities and characteristics they want to see represented in future re-development and/or re-modeling of the town's commercial areas. The community's input will serve as the foundation for the upcoming revision of the town's commercial design standards. The meeting will be held at the town hall from 6-8pm.
- The Hamilton County Water and Wastewater Treatment Authority (WWTA) began its pilot program to address deficiencies in private sewer lateral lines on March 1<sup>st</sup>.
