

## Council Notes-April 14, 2010

- Windy Way is closed between Dunsinane and Arden Way due to the collapse of three storm water culverts. The town is currently negotiating with various engineers and contractors because the repair is complicated and includes demolition of that section of road, installing new culverts and re-building and resurfacing the road.
- The town is seeking a part-time Human Resource Coordinator to assist the town manager with HR duties such as benefits, wellness and safety programs, interviewing, hiring, and payroll. Hours will be approximately 25 per week and can be flexible. For more information, go to the town website or call the town hall. Applications are due by April 16<sup>th</sup>.
- The town recreation department will not mail out a summer recreation schedule this year as a cost-saving measure. The schedule is as follows:
- PLAYGROUND CAMP will be held the weeks of June 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. Attendees must register at the town hall between April 9<sup>th</sup> and June 4<sup>th</sup> before camps begin.
- TOWN POOL season passes are available at the town hall Monday-Friday, 8am to 4:30pm. Registration for two-week sessions of basic or advanced swimming lessons will be held April 9<sup>th</sup> through June 4<sup>th</sup> at the Town Hall. Swim team registration will also be held there on two Saturdays, April 24<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>.
- PICK UP BASEBALL players will meet at the town hall on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays at 11:30am beginning June 7<sup>th</sup> and ending on June 25<sup>th</sup>.
- On Thursday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7pm, Recreation Director Jarred Thompson and the Recreation Board will host a public input meeting in the guild room at the town hall to assess future facility and program needs as a basis for creating a long-range town recreation plan.
