

Council Notes-May 12, 2010

- The WWTA has sent out letters to owners of dwellings with gravity sewer connections. Please sign and return the required forms in the stamped and addressed envelope to the WWTA as soon as possible. The WWTA hopes to complete all inspection, testing and repair of private sewer lines in the town by fall. These repairs will considerably improve the quality of town streams.
- On Thursday, May 13th from 6-7pm at Nolan Elementary School, the WWTA will hold a community meeting to explain what citizens can expect when WWTA work begins in their neighborhoods. For additional information go to www.hamiltontn.gov/wwta/pslp.html.
- The council concluded its review of the budget on May 6th. However, the budget will be finalized and read in June instead of May as originally projected. The council will be applying an extra \$375,000 principal to the school note this year, which will lower the debt from \$4.5 to \$4.2 million.
- The engineering study has begun to address the collapsed culverts under Windy Way, the re-positioning of the gas and water lines, and the consequent repair of the road surface.
- At its regular May 6th meeting, the Planning Commission approved the closure of a road stub at the intersection of Windy Way and Hidden Brook lane. The decision is subject to easements acceptable to EPB and Comcast.
- Recreation director Jarred Thompson is aware of several “dead spots” in the gym floor. Although the town can’t budget a new floor this year, Mr. Thompson will oversee repairs.
- The town pool will open Memorial Day weekend. Both residents and non-residents are required to have passes, which are available at the Town Hall. Those without passes will not be allowed to enter.
