

## Council Notes-June 30, 2010

- The council approved several capital projects in the 2010-11 budget: re-roofing the MACC; updating the phone system; re-siding the town hall, paving two miles of streets; and, replacing water lines on Palisades Road. There will be no property tax, no water rate, and no storm water fee increases this year.
- The 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade will be Monday, July 5<sup>th</sup>. Begin lining up at Alexian Village at 9:30am. Walkers, bicyclists and strollers gather in the driveway in front. Cars line up on Signal Point Road and floats and trucks on Ohio Avenue. The parade starts at 10am. Mayor Bill Lusk and a policeman will be on duty to direct traffic. The route will be James to Ohio then Texas and back to James to the Signal Mountain Golf and Country Club.
- The Lion's Club's annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration and barbecue will be underway at Althaus Park from 10am to 4pm. Bring the family and enjoy the fun.
- This year shuttle bus service will be available to ease parking congestion. Park at Signal Crest United Methodist church and ride the shuttle free to and from Althaus Park between 10am and 4pm.
- A fireworks display will be held at the golf course at 9:30pm. Bring a blanket and/or some chairs and enjoy.
- Remember, all town offices will be closed Monday, July 5<sup>th</sup>. Monday's garbage will be collected on Friday, July 2nd, before the holiday weekend.
- There are two openings on the Transportation Sub-Committee of the Citizen's Advisory Board, which meets monthly. There is also an opening on the Health, Education and Housing Facility Board, a 5-member board that meets only once or twice a year. If interested, contact the town manager.
