

Council Notes-July 7, 2010

- At its agenda meeting on June 28th, the council approved the FY 2010 Amended Budget and the FY 2011 Budget ordinances. The council also approved a Design Review Commission application fee, new zoning language regarding business licenses to allow certified and licensed massage therapists to operate in the town, and adopted DRC Design Standards and Principles that had previously existed in the Zoning Ordinance into the Town Code.
- The Council also discussed a revised noise ordinance proposed by Police Chief Boyd Veal and minor amendments in language to clarify problematic regulations in the Sign Ordinance until its thorough review and revision is completed this fall. A special hearing on the amendments to the Sign Ordinance and a first reading will be held at the next regular council meeting on July 12th at 6:30pm.
- The Signal Mountain Library has an opening for a part-time clerk to work under the direction of the librarian. Applicants should possess a high school diploma; working knowledge of library operations and the Dewey Decimal system; and, experience with computers and software applications. Responsibilities include circulation desk duties, shelving, processing and recording fines, assisting with special projects and other duties as assigned. Information is available on the town website. - Recreation Director Jarred Thompson, employee Mark Davis, and Town Manager Honna Rogers attended the State Local Parks and Recreation Funds Grant workshop in Murfreesboro recently to better understand the process for procuring grants for needed repairs at the town pool. Applications are due in mid-August.
