- The Recreation Board will hold a public hearing for citizen input at 7:00pm on Thursday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, in preparation for the submission of a grant application to the state for necessary repairs to the town pool.
- Vice Mayor Susan Robertson will stand for re-election at the end of her term in November. Hershel Dick and Paul Hendricks have stated they will not stand for re-election this year. Potential candidates should contact the Hamilton County Election Commission.
- On Friday, July 16<sup>th</sup>, the Library and the Playhouse will serve tea and lemonade on the library patio beginning at 6pm before the performance of Brigadoon. Bring a picnic and join the fun.
- The Mountain Arts Community Centers (MACC) has an opening for a part-time staff position under the direction of the MACC director. A high school diploma and a working knowledge of MS Word and Excel are necessary. Responsibilities include registering students, assisting teachers, light office work, and projects as assigned.
