

## Council Notes-September 29, 2010

- The town council will meet for a work session on Monday, October 4<sup>th</sup> at 10am to discuss the next regular meeting agenda, fire hydrants on Palisades Road and Balmoral Drive, and other issues as necessary.
- Mayor Bill Lusk will present his annual “State of the Town 2009-10” report to the community at the council’s next regular meeting on Monday, October 11<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm.
- At its recent meeting, the Design Review Commission approved a final sign for CLS Lighting whose grand opening will be held at Signal Plaza on October 1<sup>st</sup> at 10am. The DRC approved a temporary gravel driveway for reasons of safety at Signal Crest United Methodist Church’s property at 308 Laurel Street, discussed Signal Crest’s plans to build a permanent driveway addition there, and the need for site plan approval before construction begins.
- The Tree Board decided against selling trees this year at the MACC’s Fall Hodgepodge on Friday and Saturday, October 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, due to the drought. Instead, the Board will be selling Treegators and Ooze Tubes--irrigation bags for slow watering to help young trees survive drought.
- The Mountain Business Association will sponsor a Town Council candidate’s forum on Sunday, October 10<sup>th</sup> at 5:30pm at the Signal Mountain Golf and Country Club. Candidates taking part in the forum are Jason Bowling, Dick Gee, Frank Preston, Jeremy Rardin, Bill Wallace and incumbent Susan Robertson. The public is invited.
- Town Manager Honna Rogers attended the TN City Managers’ Association fall conference in Knoxville last week. Informational topics reviewed and discussed were “Using Performance Excellence to Drive Results”; the “TN Law Enforcement Accreditation Program”; “Our Economy: What’s Next”; “Land Acquisition”; “New Healthcare Legislation”; and, “Loss Control Guidelines for Contracts”.
