- The \$317,000 in tax money that the council voted to designate to the school debt in 2006 was never actually transferred due to several changes in town management at that time. This week, the town corrected the error and paid \$330,000 (the original amount with interest) on the principal. The new balance of the school debt is now \$3,875,000 million down from the original \$7.7 million.
- At its November 23rd regular meeting, the Design Review Commission approved signage for a new business, Saving Face Aesthetics, and denied additional signage for Gruthries. The Commission also continued working on its review and revision of the town's commercial guidelines.
- Everyone is invited to attend a retirement reception for Police Captain Gregg Hall on December 3rd from 2-4pm at the Town Hall. Captain Hall is retiring after 30 years of service. He will be greatly missed.
- A ribbon-cutting ceremony honoring the re-opening of Webco Graphics at its new location at the Signal Mountain Business Center (the former SMMS) will be held on December 2nd at 10:30am. Everyone is welcome.
