

## Council Notes-January 12, 2011

- At its work session on January 3rd, the council approved resolutions appointing Tammy Rardin and Buffy Harper to the MACC Board. It continued a discussion of Alexian Village's request for a beer license and discussed a recommendation by the Parks Board to work with the Tennessee River Gorge Trust to place a conservation easement on Rainbow Lake and other town properties. A public input meeting on an easement will be held soon.
- At its regular meeting on January 6<sup>th</sup>, the Planning Commission re-elected Melissa Cantrell chairman, Cheryl Graham vice chairman, and Wayne Williams secretary. The vote for each was unanimous. In other business Jim O'Kelley was granted a 2-year extension on his preliminary plat for the Conner Creek Subdivision, and Dr. Robert Spaulding presented a request for equestrian-based commercial uses for his Shackelford Ridge Road property. The property is zoned Residential Estate and allows horses for private use only at 1 horse per 3 acres and 2 acres for each additional horse.
- SMMHS student Logan Mills has chosen to facilitate the building of a skate park as his senior project. On January 6<sup>th</sup>, he presented the Recreation Board with the results of his research to generate financing for his project. The Rec Board agreed to consider where a skate park could be placed and how it could be insured as Logan continues to gather support.
- Public Works Director Loretta Hopper reported the town's crew spent 100 man-hours and 80 tons of salt to deal with the 3 significant snow and ice events in December.
