

## Council Notes-February 16, 2011

- Town Manager Honna Rogers has reminded the council that April 30<sup>th</sup> is the expiration date for the six-month trial period allowing door-to-door solicitation Saturdays from 10am-2pm. Neither the council nor the town manager have heard any complaints from citizens to date. Unless otherwise directed by the community, the council will allow Saturday solicitation permanently. A discussion and vote will take place March 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm at the Town Hall.
- Ms. Rogers recently attended a class on National Incident Management System (NIMS) training, which is required for all governmental employees who may be involved in making decisions during a disaster. In order to receive Homeland Security Funding, town personnel and the council are required to have and maintain NIMS training.
- The MACC will host a series of public input meetings to hear how the community would like to see the MACC develop. The sessions are scheduled as follows: Mar. 10<sup>th</sup> at the MACC from 10am-1pm; March 15<sup>th</sup> at Nolan from 7-9pm; and, March 19<sup>th</sup> at the Alexian from 1-3pm. Everyone is invited.
- The council has asked Ms. Rogers to schedule a one-day strategic planning session for members to discuss, prioritize, and address current issues facing the town and plan for long-term solutions. Date and location will be announced.
- The Spot, formerly the Hole Scoop, will have its grand opening and ribbon cutting on February 18<sup>th</sup>, from 10am-2pm at its new store at Signal Mountain Plaza. Come and enjoy complimentary coffee and samples.
- Please do not leave plastic bags at the recycle center. The town does not have the capability to recycle them at this time. Instead, take them to Walmart. They have both collection containers and the means to recycle plastic bags.
