

Council Notes-April 27, 2011

- At a called meeting on April 18th, the council passed an amendment to the Alcohol Ordinance allowing Continuing Care Retirement Communities located in High Density Residential zones to sell alcohol and established a water rate schedule reflecting a 14.97% increase from Tennessee American. The council discussed Sprout Construction's bid to replace Town Hall siding with Hardie board, which is an expense budgeted last year. The Design Review Commission will consider color and style at its next meeting.
- The council will meet at 11am on Monday, May 2nd, to begin review of the 2011-12 fiscal year budget, which must be fine-tuned and accepted by June 30th.
- The Design Review Commission will host a public input meeting on the first draft of a new sign ordinance on Tuesday, May 10th. Citizens and business owners are encouraged to drop by Town Hall between 2 & 4pm or 6 & 8pm to review the draft and share comments and suggestions.
- Playground camp is scheduled for the first 3 weeks in June. The cost for each week is \$60 for residents and \$75 for non-residents. If fewer than 35 children enroll, camp for that week will be cancelled. For more information, contact the Town Hall.
