

Council Notes-May 4, 2011

- At its regular meeting on April 26th, the Design Review Commission reviewed an application by the Town of Signal Mountain to approve Hardie board replacement siding for the Town Hall. The choices of style (board and batten) as well as color (Monterey Taupe) were approved; however, the DRC recommended that the town consult a design professional and the siding contractor to assure proper installation.
- The DRC is making final preparations for its upcoming open-house-style citizens' input meeting. The DRC's draft of the updated Sign Ordinance will be on display for citizens and business owners' comments and suggestions. Stop by the Town Hall on Tuesday, May 10th, to review and comment between the hours of 2-4pm or 6-8pm.
- At the next regular council meeting on Monday, May 9th, Council Member Annette Allen will give a presentation on the merits of placing conservation easements on certain town parklands.
- The Public Works Department reports that installation of the town's new 5-way LED traffic signal is underway. Replacement reflector and pothole repair have begun. Citizens are asked to call Town Hall to report the location (or nearest address) of a pothole.
- Playground camp is scheduled for the first 3 full weeks in June. The cost for each week is \$60 for residents and \$75 for non-residents. If fewer than 35 children enroll, camp for that week will be cancelled. For more information contact the Town Hall.
- This Saturday, May 7th from 8am-2pm, a backhoe will load mulch at the Recycle Center. There will be a \$5 charge per vehicle to offset fuel and staff over-time costs.
