The Council is seeking citizen input on the idea of preserving certain town parks and green spaces by entering into conservation easement agreements with The Tennessee River Gorge Trust. Registration for the Library's Summer Reading Program begins at 11 am on June 7th. Special events are planned for each Tuesday at 11 am in June and July, with the Grand Finale at the Signal Mountain Swimming Pool on Tuesday, July 26 at 7 pm.

- The "Flying Brushes" Art Show and Sale will occur June 3 and 4 at MACC from 6-9 pm. Also on the 4<sup>th</sup> at the MACC will be "Finesse" Jazz/Funk Concert at 8:00PM.
- Note: Beginning June 6<sup>th</sup>, summer hours at the Transfer Station will be Monday – Thursday 7:00-5:30 and Saturday 8-4. It will be closed on Fridays. Normal hours will resume Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Playground camp is scheduled for the first three full weeks in June. The cost for each week is \$60 for residents and \$75 for non-residents. If fewer than 35 children enroll, camp for that week will be cancelled. For more information contact the Town Hall.
- The Town will be at the recycle center loading mulch for citizens from 8:00 am - 2:00 pm, the first Saturday of every month through October 1<sup>st</sup>. The cost is \$5 per load.
