- At its next agenda meeting on Monday, June 27th at 10:30am, the council will hold a public hearing prior to considering a vote on the adoption of the fiscal year 2011-12 budget.
- The Board of Zoning Appeals has an opening for a new member. The BZA is responsible for hearing, granting or denying requests for variances or special exceptions to the Zoning Ordinance as well as for hearing and deciding appeals to any alleged error in the enforcement of the Zoning Ordinance. Applications may be downloaded on the town website. For information, contact the Town Manager.
- The Town Hall building and the adjoining Paul M. Mathis Gymnasium, built in the 1970's, are showing their age. Recent inspections have revealed significant water damage and rot all around the exterior of the buildings, primarily due to lack of gutters and deferred maintenance, as well as insect habitation in the siding with consequent bird damage. The council is studying various cost effective proposals to address these issues.
- Town Manager Honna Rogers and Council Member Bill Wallace attended the annual Tennessee Municipal League Conference in Murfreesboro June 12-14. Classes attended were Social Media Policies, Public Leadership, Designing Healthy Communities, Communication Excellence, Sign Ordinances, Workplace Incivility and Retail Recruitment. In addition, Mr. Wallace completed Level II of the Elected Officials Academy, under the auspices of the Municipal Technical Advisory Service.
- The Water Department is replacing lines along Palisades Road and portions of Balmoral and Sunset Drives. Work will last approximately six months. Interruptions in service for residents in that area may occur. For more information contact the Town Hall.
