- The council's next agenda meeting will be held August 30th at 10am. Scheduled for discussion are an update on automatic water meter reading, a revision of proposed Water Department policies, and conservation easements.
- Due to new state requirements, the town building official cannot conduct electrical inspections. Beginning September 1st, Hamilton County will take over that responsibility. Permits may be obtained at the Development Resource Center at 1250 Market Street. All other permits will be handled at Town Hall.
- A plaque honoring the late Karen Shropshire for her work to found the Mountain Arts Community Center and serve for many years as its director will be dedicated at 7pm on Monday, August 29th. A reception will follow.
- The new "MACC Fall 2011, Class Catalogue and Events" is available online at signalmountainmacc.org. Classes offered include art, music, Kindermusic, photography, pottery, ballet and dance, theatre, sewing, yoga, tai ji, karate, and Weight Watchers.
