

Council Notes-August 31, 2011

- On August 24th, Mayor Bill Lusk and Town Manager Honna Rogers attended a stakeholders meeting with TDOT officials regarding the road up the mountain. Three options were discussed: reconstruct the current roadway; construct a new road in the area of the W; or make spot repairs to the existing roadway. When the final report is completed, TDOT will host a town meeting to discuss its findings.
- The September 1st Planning Commission meeting is cancelled.
- Beginning September 1st, Hamilton County will be responsible for electrical inspections. Permits may be obtained at the Development Resource Center at 1250 Market Street. All other permits will be handled at Town Hall.
- According to state code, town business owners are required to display street addresses at their front entrances. Building Official Chuck Martin also suggests that business owners in shopping centers designate rear entrances with street numbers in case of emergencies.
- On Friday, September 2nd at 4:00pm, Congressman Chuck Fleishman will host a town-hall meeting in the Council Room at the Signal Mtn. Town Hall.
- A money dive will be held at the pool for children 12 and under at 10:30am on Labor Day, September 5th, the last day the pool will be open this year.
- Town offices will be closed Monday, September 5th in observance of the Labor Day Holiday. Monday garbage collection is re-scheduled for Friday, September 2nd.
- The council will award the bid for pool renovations provided by a Local Parks & Recreation Fund grant at the Sept. 12th regular meeting. Renovations include re-plastering the main pool, separating its filtration system from the baby pool, and re-concreting the deck.
