- The council has received a request from Poppy's Smokehouse, LLC, a mobile kitchen currently located at 3901 Taft Highway, to add language to the Zoning Ordinance to allow a mobile kitchen to operate in the town. Poppy's would like to locate in the Pruett's parking lot or in the grassy area beside Pruett's. Since this request will require a change in zoning, the council is seeking public input. Citizens are asked to email their comments to council members or call the town manager.
- At its regular Sept. 12 meeting, the council recognized the Signal Mountain Playhouse as an outstanding community asset and commended it for 40 years of productions that have entertained, inspired, and delighted citizens of the mountain.
- The council also awarded a contract to B & W Contractors, Inc., for the installation of the sidewalk along James Blvd. and authorized the town manager to enter into a professional services agreement with Arcadis U.S. for the Water Department. Arcadis recently completed a hydraulic modeling system for the town.
