- On Tuesday, October 11th, at 6:30pm, the Parks Board will host a public meeting at the Town Hall to discuss its recommendation that the town ask the Tennessee River Gorge Trust to hold conservation easements on certain town parks, including Rainbow Lake, in order to protect them in perpetuity. - On Monday, October 10th, the council will hold a public hearing at 6:30pm at the town hall on a request from Poppy's Barbecue, 3901 Taft Highway, to allow a mobile kitchen to park and operate in the parking lot or grassy area adjacent to Pruett's. Since this request will require a change in zoning, the council is seeking community input. To comment, please email the council, contact the town manager or attend the hearing.
- At its meeting on Thursday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, at 6pm at the Town Hall, the Planning Commission will review a revised plat that merges two lots into one at 321 North Palisades. The Commission will also begin its review of New Street Criteria and receive additional training from the Regional Planning Commission.
- The week of October 9-13 is National Fire Prevention Week. On Tuesday, October 11<sup>th</sup>, Fire Department personnel will visit the Library during "Storytime".
- The Library will team with AT&T to teach a class, "Computer Safety for Seniors," on Thursday, October 13 at 6:30pm at the Library.
- The Health Educational and Housing Facility Board has an opening. The Board is an independent corporation organized under the state to provide low-rate bond financing for health care facilities in the town. Meetings are the second Tuesday in May or as needed.
