- The town is accepting applications for several positions on town boards. Board descriptions and responsibilities are available on the town website. Application forms may be downloaded or picked up at the town hall. The following boards have openings: Board of Zoning Appeals, Design Review Commission, Health Education and Housing, Library, Mountain Arts Community Center, Parks, Planning Commission, Recreation, Storm Water Appeals, Transportation Subcommittee, and Tree Board. - At its October meeting, the Design Review Commission approved signs for the Paw Shop, the paint color for the Town Hall and the pool building, and preliminary planning for an addition at the Alexian Village. At a workshop meeting on Nov. 2nd, the DRC completed a final draft of the Sign Ordinance. The draft is now ready for review and input from the council, town attorney, local businesses and the public.

- The Tree Board urges citizens to plant native hardwood trees to replace those mature hardwoods lost in storms this year. Now is the perfect time for planting.
- The Town recommends that citizens turn off water service for irrigation systems during winter months to save an average of \$130. The cost of turning the meter on in the spring is \$25.
- Remember to separate leaves from brush and place them at the edge of the yard away from utility poles, mailboxes and other structures. Don't place leaves in drainage ditches, streets, parks or private lots. A map posted on the town website shows where the leaf crew is currently working.
