- At its Nov. 16th regular meeting, the council, acting temporarily as the Beer Board, approved beer permits for Pie Slingers and On the List Catering; authorized the approval of a state mandated Debt Policy; the purchases of a police car and a fire engine, both budgeted under the Vehicle Replacement Plan; and, voted to establish a \$25 fee to reconnect irrigation system water service disconnected for the winter.
