- Please remember town employees at Christmas. The Police and Fireman's fund will be divided among the police and firemen. The Employee Christmas Fund will be divided among all other town employees. Donations to each fund may be dropped off at the Town Hall at 1111 Ridgeway.
- During this holiday season, remember to Shop local! Buy Local! Of every \$100 spent in locally owned stores, \$68 returns to the community through taxes, payroll and other expenditures.
- Positions are still available on the following town boards: Planning, Storm water Appeals, and Transportation. Board descriptions and applications are available on the town website. Please submit applications to the Town Manager, 1111 Ridgeway Ave., SM 37377.
- As of December 9th, the Recycle Center will no longer be accepting latex paint. Latex paint can be properly disposed of as solid waste once it has solidified. To solidify latex paint, mix it with mulch, shredded paper or kitty litter. Leave the top off the can until the paint is solid and dispose of the can and its contents in your household garbage.
- Oil based paint is considered hazardous waste. Sig. Mtn. citizens are encouraged to drop it off at the Recycle Center to be disposed of properly.
- Please note the Christmas Garbage schedule: Curbside garbage pickup on Monday, Dec. 26th has been re-scheduled for Tuesday, Dec. 27th. The Transfer Station will be closed Fri., Dec. 23rd-26th. The Recycle Center will be closed Fri., Dec. 23-26th.
- Reminders: The Town Recycling Center is now a single-stream recycling center, which means no more sorting. Also, for safety, remember the 3-foot rule when driving next to cyclists.
