- At its December 12th meeting, the council passed the review and revisions of the Donation Policy and the Sign Regulations on first reading. Bryan Wright of Johnson, Murphy and Wright, presented the town's official audit for fiscal year 2011. He gave the town an Unqualified Opinion, an A+ in CPA jargon. Mr. Wright and the council congratulated Finance Director Mark Johnson and Town Manager Honna Rogers for their excellent management of town funds.
- The council appointed the following individuals to town boards: Doug Fuston and Ashley Henry to Zoning Appeals; Louis Glendenning and Scott Ferguson to Condemnation; Claire Griesinger, Karna Levitt and Vance Travis to Design Review; Owen Leslie and Tom Francescon to Health and Housing; Clif Cleaveland to Library; Sandra McCrea to MACC; Mary Broerman to Parks; Tom Turner, Bonnie Hamilton, and Chris Howley to Recreation; Sam Powell and Rusty Sewell to Stormwater Appeals; and Paige Patterson to Tree.
- In a public hearing on Dec. 13th, the Alexian Village presented its proposal to the Design Review Commission to demolish a 6-unit retirement cluster to build a 100,000 sq. ft. 5-story nursing care facility. Citizens voiced concerns about the size and scale of the building as not being consistent with the residential nature of the community.
