- The council's January agenda meeting will be held on Friday, January 6th at 9:30am at the Town Hall to set the agenda for the regular meeting and to discuss the pros and cons of forming a SM Youth Athletic Association.
- Tentatively scheduled for the agenda at the regular council meeting on Monday, January 9th are resolutions commending those citizens retiring in 2010 from service on town boards, second readings of the reviewed and revised Donation Policy and Sign Regulations, and a presentation of the State of the Town report by Mayor Bill Lusk.
- The Town's Revenue and Expense Report for the first quarter of FY 2012 is available on the town website under the "Government" tab. The proposed Sign Regulations are also available. Comments and suggestions are welcome.
- Councilman Dick Gee and Town Manager Honna Rogers recently attended the Tennessee Municipal League's District meeting. They received legislation updates as well as financing options available through the TML Bond Fund and claim rates from the TML Risk Management Pool. TML represents municipal interests to the State Legislature.
- The January Planning Commission meeting is cancelled. The Commission's next meeting is scheduled on Thursday, February 2nd.
- The Winter 2012 Mountain Arts Community Center class schedule is now online.
- Christmas trees (without lights or stands on them) will be collected at the curb or they can be taken to the Transfer Station and placed in the brush pile.
- The Library will be closed New Year's Eve, Saturday, December 31st. The Transfer Station and the Town Hall will be closed Monday, January 2nd for the New Year's Holiday. Curbside garbage pickup has been re-scheduled from Monday, Jan. 2nd to Tuesday, January 3rd.
