- The January Planning Commission meeting is cancelled. The Commission's next meeting will be Thursday, February 2nd.
- The council's January agenda meeting will be held on Friday, January 6<sup>th</sup> at 9:30am at the Town Hall in order to set the agenda for the regular meeting on January 9<sup>th</sup>, discuss possible changes to the take-home vehicle policy, the pros and cons of forming a SM Youth Athletic Association, and the purchase of building permit software.
- Tentatively scheduled for the agenda at the regular council meeting on Monday, January 9<sup>th</sup> are resolutions commending those citizens retiring in 2010 from service on town boards, second readings of the reviewed and revised Donation Policy and Sign Regulations, and a presentation of the State of the Town report by Mayor Bill Lusk.
- The Town's Revenue and Expense Report for the first quarter of FY 2012 is available on the town website under the "Government" tab. The proposed Sign Regulations are also available. Comments and suggestions are welcome.

- Remember to recycle your Christmas boxes and wrapping paper. Christmas trees (without lights or stands on them) will be collected at the curb or they can be taken to the Transfer Station and placed in the brush pile.
- As of December 9<sup>th</sup>, the Recycle Center no longer accepts latex paint. Latex paint can be properly disposed of as solid waste once it has solidified. To solidify latex paint, mix it with mulch, shredded paper or kitty litter. Leave the top off the can until the paint is solid and dispose of the can and its contents in your household garbage.
