- At its next agenda meeting on Friday, January 27th at 9:30am, the council will discuss the possibility of creating a SM Youth Athletic Association; a proposed social media policy and sprinkler system to be installed at the MACC to meet fire codes; proposed revisions to the Board Ordinance and amendments to the Take Home Vehicle Policy; the purchase of building inspection software; and a six month update on town finances.
- Tentatively, the agenda for the regular meeting on February 13th at 6:30 at the Town Hall includes: an honorary resolution recognizing Friday, March 2nd as Arbor Day; resolutions approving New Street Criteria, adopting a social media policy and amendments to a new Take Home Vehicle Policy; the second reading of the DRC Principles and Standards and the Sign Regulations as well as the first reading of the Board Ordinance.
