- At its January 27th agenda meeting, the council reviewed the revised Board Ordinance and approved Sign Regulations on first reading; discussed the establishment of a SM youth athletic association, the acquisition of building inspection software, and fire apparatus to outfit the town's new fire pumper. It also discussed revisions of the Take Home Vehicle Policy and New Street Criteria, updates on the Palisades Rd. water line project, and the installation of a MACC sprinkler system. Finance Director Mark Johnson presented a 6-month financial update, and the Town Manager shared plans to propose a social media policy.
- The town's quarterly financial report is available on the town website.
- Town Manager Honna Rogers recognized Engineering Tech Cliff Fite as Employee of the Quarter.
- The Tree Board met January 26th to discuss plans for an SMMHS volunteer service day on February 17th to continue removing invasive species at Memorial Park and to apply fresh mulch to trees at the elementary schools. The Board also discussed activities planned for Friday, March 2nd, which has been designated as Arbor Day this year. The Board will plant trees with 5th graders at Nolan and Thrasher schools, and Girl Scout Troop Number 40318 will plant trees at Bachman and the MACC.
- At its January 24th meeting, the Design Review Commission visited the site of the Alexian's proposed new 100,000 square foot, 5-story nursing care facility and reviewed signage for Sprout Roofing, Art Happens Here, Kids Klub, and Rafael's Italian Restaurant and Pizzeria.
