- The Planning Commission met February 2nd to begin its final review of Subdivision Regulations Articles 1-4. Articles 5-6 will be reviewed at the next meeting. Missy Cantrell nominated Wayne Williams as chairman, herself as secretary, and Annette Allen nominated Cheryl Graham as vice chairman. The Commission elected the slate unanimously.
- At its Monday, February 13th regular meeting, the council will recognize Arbor Day as March 2nd, approve New Street Criteria, and adopt a new Take Home Vehicle Policy. In addition the council will consider passing the new Sign Regulations on second reading and a revised Board Ordinance on first reading.
- The Mountain Arts Community Center has two board openings. The MACC Board is advisory to the MACC director, the town manager and the town council to provide and facilitate policies, general improvements, programs and other functions to benefit the advancement and success of the MACC.
