- On Sunday, March 11th, the Recreation Board will hold a public input meeting to discuss the idea of participating in the Scenic City Football League. Those interested are urged to attend.
- The council opened its agenda meeting on March 2nd at Thrasher to celebrate Arbor Day. The meeting was continued at Town Hall where the council discussed month-to-month fees for library patrons who will be annexed on January 1st; an agreement with the SM Golf & Country Club regarding plantings; and, recent improvements at the MACC. The council also passed the revised Board Ordinance on second reading and, on first reading, a revised fee schedule for rental and other associated fees at the MACC.
- The March 12th regular council meeting agenda includes authorizing the town manager to enter into a waste-hauling contract, appointing members to the MACC Board, and considering a second reading of the revised MACC fee schedule.
- Nolan and Thrasher selected 10 finalists out of 225 Arbor Day Poster contest submissions. The finalists' posters will be on display at the March 12th council meeting, and the winners, Taegan Bunch from Thrasher and George Andreescu from Nolan, will be recognized by council resolution.
