- The Alexian Village has requested to appear before the Design Review Commission at a public meeting on Tuesday, April 24<sup>th</sup> at 6pm to request approval of their plans to build a 100,000 square foot, 5-story health and rehabilitation center by the summer of 2014. The new nursing home facility is part of a \$32 million renovation plan for the Alexian Village, now owned by Ascension Health Care of St. Louis, MO. Upon completion of the new building, the Alexian plans to convert the old nursing home facility into 42 assisted living apartments and the former Signal Mountain Inn into 13 independent living apartments. The Alexian project has been granted approvals to proceed from both the TN Health Services and Development Agency and the Hamilton County Water and Wastewater Treatment and Treatment Authority (WWTA). - The Mountain Arts Community Center Board has an opening. Applications are available at the Town Hall or may be downloaded from the town website.
