- To date the town manager reports that almost all town departments are 1-12% under budget, and she projects a balanced budget at the end of the fiscal year. The initial presentation of the proposed FY 2012-13 budget by the Town Manager to the Council will occur on Monday, May 7th at 3pm at the Town Hall. The meeting is expected to last several hours. The public is welcome to attend.
- Renovations to the pool are almost complete thanks to last year's Local Parks and Recreation Fund Grant. Be sure to obtain or renew pool passes before the summer rush. Passes are available Monday-Friday at the Town Hall. Playground Camp applications are also available. Three camp sessions will be held this summer: June 4-8, June 18-22, and June 25-29. Students from kindergarten through 5th grade are eligible to attend. The cost is \$60 per child for residents and \$75 per child for non-residents.
- The Council thanks Lion's Club member and woodworker Phil Johnson for the works of art he has donated to the MACC. Five beautifully framed "Historic Americana" prints, by artist John Falter, may be viewed in Room 5 along with two woodblock "paintings" of Phil's own creation.
- The Mountain Arts Community Center Board has an opening. Applications are available at the Town Hall or may be downloaded from the town website.
- Generally, when the Town Hall is closed so are the Recycle Center and the Transfer Station. All schedule changes are noted on the website, in "Council Notes", and at the Town Hall. Do not leave items outside the Recycle Center when it is closed. Violators will be subject to a littering citation.
