- Representatives from Alexian Village appeared before the Design Review Commission on Tuesday, April 24th to request approval to move forward with a 3-phase, \$32 million expansion plan. The DRC approved the interior renovation of the existing Alexian Inn into 13 independent living apartments; approved the interior renovation of the existing Heath Care Center into 42 assisted living apartments; and approved the construction of a new 100,000 square foot, 5-story, 133 room skilled nursing facility with 10 specific conditions that the Alexian will address at the DRC's next regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, May 22nd at 6pm.
- The Planning Commission will meet on Thursday, May 3rd to discuss the proposed final draft of the subdivision regulations. Citizens may review the proposed draft on the town website.
- The initial presentation of the proposed FY 2012-13 budget by the Town Manager to the Council will occur on Monday, May 7th at 3pm at the Town Hall. The meeting is expected to last several hours. The public is welcome to attend.
- The Mountain Arts Community Center Board has an opening. Applications are available at the Town Hall or may be downloaded from the town website.
- Please do not place latex paint in household garbage unless it has been solidified. When non-solidified paint is hauled, it spills onto the streets and equipment. When it is compacted, it contaminates the landfill. To solidify latex paint, mix it with mulch, shredded paper or kitty litter. Once it is solidified, remove the top and place the can in a plastic bag. Town citizens may drop oil-based paint at the Recycle Center.
- Remember: In a crosswalk, pedestrians--not cars--have the right-of-way.
