

## Council Notes-May 9, 2012

- At its regular monthly meeting May 3rd, the Planning Commission reviewed a citizen's request for a setback variance to enable his family to keep backyard chickens. The neighbors supported the request and the variance was granted. In other business, the Commission continued its review of the proposed revision of the Subdivision Regulations. The proposal is available for review on the town website.
- The Design Review Commission called a special meeting on Tuesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>. The Commission reviewed proposed signage for a satellite office for Sawrie Orthodontics at Signal Crossing and a new Subway at Ashley Plaza. An awning sign for Sawrie Orthodontics was approved minus the logo, and two wall signs were approved for Subway, one over the front entrance and one on the street-side of the building.
- Vice Mayor Susan Robertson and Town Manager Honna Rogers represented the town at the Thirty-Fourth Chattanooga Area Leadership Prayer Breakfast on Tuesday, May 1st.

- The Mountain Arts Community Center Board has an opening. Applications are available at the Town Hall and on the town website.
- Please do not place latex paint in household garbage unless it has been solidified. When non-solidified paint is hauled, it spills onto the streets and equipment. When it is compacted, it contaminates the landfill. To solidify latex paint, mix it with mulch, shredded paper or kitty litter. Once it is solidified, remove the top and place the can in a plastic bag. Town citizens may drop oil-based paint at the Recycle Center.
