- The town has received a response from the Chattanooga Market with respect to its Request for Proposal to operate the 2012 Fall Hodgepodge, to be held Friday and Saturday, October 5-6 from 10am-5pm. The Market will plan, coordinate, promote, staff, operate, and provide accounting for the event with a proposed split of the net profits 55% MACC/45% Market for the first year to be adjusted to a 60%-40% split in subsequent years.
- The Planning Commission will hold a special meeting on Thursday, May 17th at 6pm to continue its review of the proposed Subdivision Regulations and consequent revisions to the Zoning Ordinance.
- The newly renovated pool will open Saturday, May 26th at 11am. Resident cards are required to enter. Cards for current residents are free. Cards for non-resident families cost \$100. Family pool passes cost \$200. Both Resident Cards and pool passes are available at the Town Hall M-F from 8am-4:30pm. Individual passes are also available. Avoid the last minute rush!
- Playground Camp applications are available at the Town Hall. Three camp sessions will be held this summer: June 4-8, June 18-22, and June 25-29. Students from kindergarten through 5th grade are eligible to attend. The cost is \$60 per child for residents and \$75 per child for non-residents.
