

## Council Notes-May 23, 2012

- The council held a special meeting on May 14<sup>th</sup> at 5pm to continue its review of the FY13 Budget. Of the \$7.3 million obligated to pay for the new schools, a debt of only \$2.5 million remains. Several capital projects were added this year: repairs to the public safety building; a purchase of 50 fire hydrants to be installed in Fox Run and Windtree; a replacement gym floor; architectural services in anticipation of building a public works facility; and, water line improvements on Kentucky.
- At its regular May 14th meeting, the council appointed Dick Gee to represent the town on the WWTa Board and authorized the Town Manager to enter into an agreement with the Chattanooga Market to operate the 2012 Fall Hodgepodge to benefit the MACC; to enter into a contract with Consolidated Pipe and Supply Co., Inc, for materials for
- water improvements; to accept two change orders for unforeseen repairs completed by Royal Pools; to award a contract to Phaltless, Inc., for the paving of Primrose Way and Primrose Circle; to enter into an agreement with Blue Cross Blue Shield for medical insurance for town employees at a 6.8% reduction; and, to renew the town's auditing contract with Johnson, Murphy & Wright, P.C. at a \$350 increase.
- On Thursday, May 24<sup>th</sup> from 5-7pm, the Recreation Department will host an Open House and ribbon cutting to mark the completion of the newly renovated town pool. Everyone is invited! Come tour the facility and buy your pool passes early.
- Town offices will be closed and garbage collection service suspended on Memorial Day, Monday, May 28<sup>th</sup>. Monday's garbage will be collected the next day, Tuesday May 29<sup>th</sup>.
